

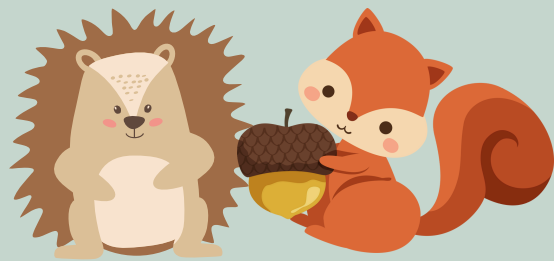

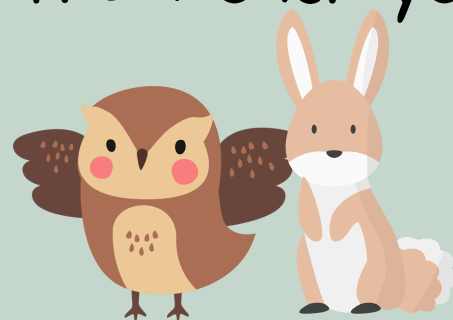

Swimming Pool Volunteer Information sessions - Wednesday 26th February 8.45am and 2.25pm

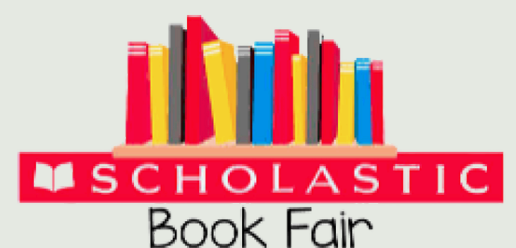
