Friends of Barnett Wood ONLINE Meeting - Wednesday 15th October 7.30pm

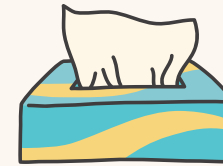
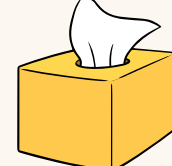
