## Red Nose Day for Comic Relief - Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March



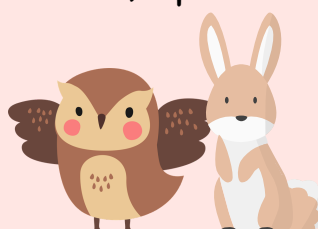
